## Mid-Atlantic USATF (MAUSATF) Officials Clinic at Penn Relays

The annual Officials Clinic at the Penn Relays is an excellent way for new and existing officials to work multiple events during the initial days of the Penn Relays.

During the clinic, participants receive one-on-one instruction from certified USATF Officials as they shadow veteran officials working live events at the Penn Relays. In addition, participants are welcome to interact in Q&A sessions and share their personal learning experiences with track and field.

In order to participate new and existing officials must have a current USATF membership, be in good standing with USATF, and be at least an Apprentice-level certified official by **April 2, 2019**.

### What to Expect:

The first day of the clinic begins in the morning with introductions, review of clinic agenda, and a brief clinical instruction. From there the group proceeds outside to participate and observe multi-events contested at the Penn Relays. The second day of the clinic begins early with deeper clinical instruction before proceeding outside to work the second and final day of multi-events.

Attire: Khaki pants with brown belt, white button-down collared shirt with red or blue necktie, white sneakers, and a navy blue blazer. Women can opt to wear a scarf tie of red and/or blue, or a necktie as stipulated above. Participants should be prepared to dress for the weather, as the majority of the clinic is held outside.

Additional information on location, time, agenda, etc., will be sent to applicants prior to the event.

All new Mid-Atlantic officials receive a rulebook either at the clinic or by mail as part of their USATF Certification complements of MAUSATF. Please **visit the USATF website to learn about an array of [membership benefits](#), including secondary insurance.**
